## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT (VARIATION)

- The name of the school is Orchard Junior School
- The school is a community school
- The name of the governing body is "The governing body of Orchard Junior School"
- The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. Two parent governors [at least two parent governors]
  - b. One local authority governor
  - c. One headteacher
  - d. One staff governor
  - e. Seven Co-opted governors [Such number as the governing body consider necessary. The total number of co-opted governors who are eligible to be elected as staff governors, when counted with the staff governor and the headteacher, must not exceed one third of the total membership of the governing body]
- Total number of governors: Twelve
- [applicable if the term of office of one or more categories of governor is shorter than four years] The term of office of \_\_\_\_\_ [category of governor] is [insert period between one and four years]
- This instrument of government comes into effect on 31 March 2015
- This instrument was made by order of Hampshire Local Authority on 12 March 2015
- A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor).
