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| Membership: | To consist of at least six governors |
| Quorum: | Four governors to be present, including the HT or DHT |
| Meetings: | Will be held at least termly |
| Function: | To ensure that the National Curriculum and its assessment procedures are carried out effectively. |
| Chair: | Will be elected by members of the committee at the first meeting of the academic year (or when a vacancy occurs) |

The Committee will:

- be conversant with the curriculum in Key Stage 2
- focus on areas of the curriculum in accordance with the School Improvement Plan
- involve governors in the active monitoring of the School Improvement Plan through the link programme
- Ensure the appropriate monitoring of the quality of teaching arrangements are in place and that outcomes are being evaluated which focus on the standards attained by pupils
- keep abreast of current curriculum issues
- adopt the HCC approach to religious education and review arrangements for collective worship
- maintain and evaluate the school's PSHE including Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) Policy
- maintain and evaluate the school's policies that are relevant to this committee, such as Assessment Policy, Curriculum Intent Statement, Curriculum Policy Statement, E-Safety Policy, Home School Agreement, Homework Policy, and PSHE and RSE Policy
- consider reports on data as appropriate
